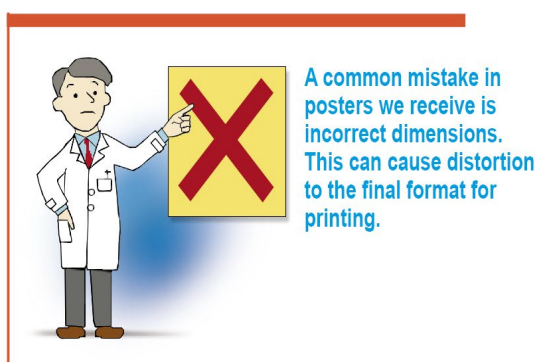

Submission will be opened in April. The deadline for submitting a poster is 1st June 2017 at 23:00 GMT+1.

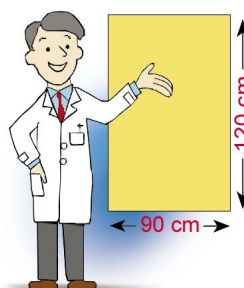
