The new ESMIT/ESO Course is organized as case-based discussions: carefully designed problems will challenge attendees to use problem solving techniques, self-directed learning strategies, team skills and multidisciplinary knowledge. Skills in analytical thinking and reflective judgment will be developed by reading and discussing complex, real-life scenarios on controversial aspects concerning the role of [18F]FDG PET-CT in management of lymphoma patients.

The programme aims mainly to Clinical Imagers (i.e. Nuclear medicine physicians, radiologists and double certifies nuclear medicine-radiologists) and Onco-Haematologists.

WORKSHOP - NOVEL ISSUES IN THE COMBINED MODALITY TREATMENT OF LYMPHOMAS

This workshop is organized in collaboration with the International Lymphoma Radiation Oncology Group (ILROG). It is divided into two parts, both covering issues which are particularly important for lymphoma radiation therapy today. One is the new immunomodulatory treatments and their integration into the combined modality setting. Both combination with radiation therapy, including the abscopal effect, and combination with other treatment modalities. The other is the NK/T-cell lymphoma, where treatment experience is fairly limited in the Western world. At the session ILROG Steering Committee members from the far East will share their experience with the treatment of this disease.
